Monument Saddles are allowed to remain on the monument year round.

The Cemetery Office has a varying seasonal selections to choose from, priced at \$67.80 These saddles are made with artificial flowers attached to an adjustable painted metal frame that clips to the top of upright monuments 4"-8" wide.

Winter Wreaths



Winter wreaths may be placed at the head of the lot and secured to a wreath stand after October 15th and may remain on the lot until April 1st.

Flower Urns

Flower urns are always welcome in the Lakefield Cemetery. For those who do not want or cannot care for their own urns, the cemetery can plant, place and maintain flower urns for you. This includes storing the urns over the winter.

Our urns are planted late April with Canadian grown bedding plants. They are then cared for in our greenhouse while they mature and bloom Flower urns are placed in the cemetery the first week of June and are cared for until Labour Day.

All urns are removed by mid-September.

Annual Flower Program

The Annual Filling Fee includes the planting, watering, weeding and fertilizing as necessary of flower urns, at a rate shown on the price list, billed in March of each year.

Clay and resin flower urns are available from the Cemetery Office. Non-resin urns are subject to breakage. Families are notified when replacement is necessary.

Endowment Urns

The Endowment Urn Fee includes the planting, watering, weeding and fertilizing as necessary of cemetery supplied urns at a rate shown on the price list. This provides peace of mind knowing that the urn will be placed for 10 or 20 years and not subject to a price increase for the term chosen.

Spring Pansy Program

A 12" pansy bowl with your choice of pink, yellow or blue pansies. These cold tolerant plants are placed out the week of May 4 and remain on the lot until the week of June 5. Spring rains and heavy dews will keep them blooming for that time period.







Fall Flower Program

A 10" pot of flowering mums in your choice of bronze, yellow or mauve, is placed out the week of September 21 and remain on the lot until the week of October 21. These flowers are watered by nature for that time period. Heavy rains and heavy dews will keep them blooming for that time period.
